Dear Parents, Pupils & Governors,

<u>Bell Boating</u> – Children in Year 5 and 6 spent a day Bell Boating on the River Avon this week. <u>Reading Books</u> – KS1 and KS2 reading books will be sent home next week. Year 1 books will be changed on Tuesdays and Year 2 on Wednesdays. Books for Reception children will be sent out in a few weeks. Children should be heard to read daily – please sign the reading record to indicate that the book has been read and comment as necessary.

<u>New Classrooms</u> – If you would like to meet your child's class teacher, see their classroom, their current work and have your child show you around, school will be open from 3.20 to 5.30pm on Tuesday 26th Sept. Please wait for your children to collect you from the playground. Formal Parents Evenings will be held on Tues 28th and Thus 30th Nov during which you will be able to discuss your child's academic progress.

<u>Parking</u> – Please consider our neighbours when parking your car near school; do not park across or opposite driveways. It is preferable to use the car park in Ward's Lane near the fire station when bringing/collecting your child from school and walk through the <u>pedestrian gate</u>. Inappropriate parking and walking in the driveways risks the safety of the children.

<u>On Line Payments</u> – SIMS Agora is a convenient and secure way of paying for school items online, with the peace of mind that your payments are made safely and securely using a debit/credit card - no more cheques, cash going missing or forms to get lost. All you need is a PC and access to the internet. If you have not yet registered to make online payments, please call into the office for a code.
