Dear Parents, Pupils & Governors,

Happy New Year and welcome to the new term.

<u>Young Voices</u> - Our Young Voices Club children participated in a group choir event at the Genting Arena in Birmingham this week. <u>School Admissions for Sept 2018</u> - To secure a school place for children born between 1st September 2013 and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2014 you need to apply online at <u>www.warwickshire.gov.uk/admissions</u> by *15th January 2018*.

**Term Time Holiday Information from the Attendance Compliance Enforcement Service** - The parents of children of compulsory school age are required to ensure that they attend school on a regular basis. The Supreme Court has made clear that attending school 'regularly' means that the children must attend school on every day that they are required to do so. As such, the parents of any child who are absent from school without authorisation for any length of time are likely to be considered as committing an offence under s444 of the Education Act 1996.

Head Teachers retain the ability to authorise leave in accordance with the Education (Pupil Registration) (England) Regulations 2006. When considering such requests for a leave of absence, the school are obliged to act within the law. Head Teachers may not grant any leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances relating to the application. If the leave is granted, head teachers are able to determine the number of school days a child can be absent for. It is for the Head Teacher to decide what is 'exceptional' and it is at their discretion if the circumstances warrant the leave to be granted. The school can only consider Leave of Absence requests which are made by the 'resident' parent. *Each application for a leave of absence will be considered on a case by case basis and on its own merits.* Where applications for leave of absence are made in advance and refused, the child will be required to be in school on the dates set out in the application. If the child is absent during that period, it will be recorded as an unauthorised absence, which may result in legal action being taken against the parent(s), by way of a Fixed Penalty Notice. Failure to make an application for leave in advance can also result in a Fixed Penalty Notice being issued to the parent(s). Your child's progress academically as well as socially is our shared priority. This information is available on our school website.

<u>Cold Weather</u> – Please send your child into school with a <u>named</u> coat, hat and gloves during this cold weather.

Homework – Please encourage your child to complete homework and return to school at the set time.
