A range of resources are available on <u>www.saferinternet.org.uk</u> to help support parents and children. Leaflets with further information to help you at home accompany this newsletter. All computer games are PEGI age rated to provide parental guidance on whether a game is suitable for a child, e.g. Call of Duty is PEGI rated 18. The majority of social media sites are NOT suitable for primary aged children - Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Pinterest and Snapchat require account holders to be at least 13 years old, Whatsapp requires account holders to be 16 and YouTube requires users to by 18 (or 13 with parental permission).
