<u>Disaster Topic</u> – Children in Year 3 and 4 have been researching the Nepalese earthquake of 2015. They have found out the scientific reasons for the disaster and how it has affected life in the local communities.

<u>Health Questionnaire</u> – Children in Year 6 have completed a health questionnaire this week with staff from the Compass School Heath Team. The survey collects data from schools across the country and informs future health policy.

<u>School Safety</u> – From Monday a number of new safety barriers will be in place in the school driveway to slow traffic and help to alleviate the parking problem. I would to like remind parents once again not to park on the grassed area in front of school and on the double yellow lines. Permanent bollards are being installed on the edge of the pavement and grassed areas to prevent this unauthorized parking. As I have explained on numerous occasions, I am concerned about the safety of the children and other pedestrians. There is plenty of car parking space available only a short walk away in the car park by the Fire Station.
