<u>Sporting News</u> - We are delighted to announce that we have achieved the <u>School Games Gold Mark Award</u> for the 2018/19 academic year. The School Games Mark is a Government led award scheme launched in 2012, facilitated by the Youth Sport Trust to reward schools for their commitment to the development of competition across their school and into the community. We are extremely proud of our pupils for their dedication to all aspects of school sport and we appreciate the support of Miss Drissell along with our staff and volunteers who help to make our participation in such a variety of activities possible.

<u>Parent Questionnaire</u> - A big thank you to all of you who completed the parent questionnaire at the end of the summer term. We triangulate your responses with those of the children, staff and governors to identify our strengths and areas for improvement. This year there were 88 questionnaires completed in which 94% of parents said that their child enjoyed school, 94% thought their child was making good progress, 100% felt their child was safe, 96% thought that teaching was good and 91% thought that the school met their child's needs. Following this feedback, we are looking closely at how we continue to develop parent communication and how we ensure that children know and understand their targets. We have also made some changes to the dinner time experience to ensure that all children feel supported.
