Dear Parents, Pupils & Governors,

The Creation Story – Children in Year 3 and 4 have been researching the story of the Creation. The children made storyboards to tell their interpretation and then acted out the story using a variety of props including shells and sand.

<u>School Safety</u> – Please do not park in the drop off or in and around the school service yard – we need to keep the access clear for the safety of our children. Parking in the disabled spaces is only allowed if you can display a disabled parking permit. Plenty of parking is available in the Ward's Lane car park, only a short walk from school.
