## Covid-19 Awareness -

- If your child is showing any of the 3 main Covid-19 symptoms: <u>high temperature, continuous cough and/or loss/change to smell/taste</u> they should isolate immediately and have a Covid-19 test. If they are unwell with any of these other symptoms: loss of appetite, diarrhoea, nausea, vomiting, extreme tiredness, headaches, joint pain, muscle ache, runny nose, sore throat, sneezing, altered consciousness or seizures it is recommended they do not come into school and have a test if you are unsure.
- <u>Covid-19 Positive Test Result</u> If your <u>child</u> receives a positive Covid-19 Test please advise school by calling 07591 541444 asap so we can make arrangements for bubble isolation if necessary.
- <u>Covid-19 Negative Test Result</u> If your <u>child</u> receives a negative Covid-19 test result please contact the office on 01789 773201 before sending your child back to school.
