Egyptian Topic – Children in Years 3 and 4 have been finding out about the Egyptian pyramids and how they were built to be used as tombs for the burial of the Pharaohs and their treasures. They discovered that each Pharaoh wanted their pyramid to be the largest and that the biggest ones were made from more than 2 million blocks of limestone.
