<u>Christmas Activities</u> - It is lovely to have the Christmas vibe emerging around our school now that we are in December. Wonderful Christmas displays are appearing along our corridors and decorations are being created for our Christmas Tree entry for the competition at St Lawrence Church next weekend. Children in Reception and KS1 have been rehearsing and filming their productions and we are busy ordering 315 oranges ready to create our Christingles.

<u>Christmas Cards</u> – Unfortunately, we are unable to have our Christmas Post Box this year. Children can still bring in cards, <u>but only to children in their own class</u>.

<u>Science</u> – Pupils in Years 5 and 6 have been investigating the forces in their science work and modelled prototype boats from plasticine before making them with foil. They tested the number of marbles the boats would hold until gravity was stronger than the upthrust. They also investigated how the viscosity of different liquids affected gravity by dropping marbles into syrup, oil and water.
