NEWSLETTER 20 – 10th February 2023

<u>Space</u> - The Reception children have been continuing their Space topic this week by creating their own planets using the icing spread onto biscuits. Pupils explored how to make different coloured icing using food colouring and discovering what happens when colours are mixed. They learnt how to make the icing thicker and discovered what happened when too much water was added. A group of children went to the Co-op to buy the biscuits, icing sugar and food colouring they needed for their learning.

<u>Science</u> – Children in Miss Powell's & Miss Waters' classes have been grouping and comparing objects based on their scientific properties. They used every day items including cocktail sticks, paper clips, elastic bands, jelly cubes and marshmallow to explore how they compared to each other using their scientific vocabulary: flexible, translucent, transparent, rigid, compressible, permeable, absorbent, stretchy. The children enjoyed a fantastic discussion about the scientific properties of these items.

<u>Safer Internet Day</u> — It was Safer Internet Day this week and the theme this year was 'Want to talk about it? Making space for conversations about life online'. The internet plays a huge part in the lives of young people today, with many playing online games, posting on social media, and using video sharing platforms. This can be used positively, helping young people learn new skills and express themselves creatively but the use of many online platforms has also been linked to low self-esteem and anxiety. They also come with a set of safeguarding risks, from the pressure to participate in dangerous challenges to cyberbullying.
