Earth Day - This week were very excited to have Mr Kidd and Mr Howe in school this week giving a presentation to children in KS2 about climate change and its effect on the planet. Children considered what activities have good and bad impacts on climate change and they wrote their own pledge saying how they could make a difference. These included turning off the lights, eating less meat, walking to school and not leaving the tap running when cleaning teeth. The AGM is now rescheduled.




