Reception Trip - The Reception children enjoyed a day at All Things Wild this week. They had an interesting talk about creatures with fur, scales or feathers. The children then went on to identify these creatures around the park. They also saw life-sized models of dinosaurs and enjoyed learning their names and finding out whether they were carnivores, herbivores, omnivores or piscivores.

<u>English</u> – Following up on their recent English work, the children in Year 1 and 2 have been writing their own versions of 'Little Red Riding Hood', but this time they are telling the tale from the wolf's point of view.

<u>Roman Games</u> – Miss Drissell's class have been learning how to play 'Jacks' this week after reading about it in 'Escape from Pompeii'.
