## NEWSLETTER 32 - 25<sup>th</sup> May 2023

<u>RE</u> – Pupils in Year 5 and 6 have been considering the question 'Why do some people believe God exists?'. They have explored some reasons such as family background, religious experience, our amazing world and the suffering that takes place. After some great in-depth, mature discussions, children have written a detailed balanced argument stating reasons why some people do believe in God and others do not.

<u>Moon Landings</u> – Children in Year 1 and 2 have been learning about moon landings this week. In the classroom, they acted out landing on the moon as if they were an astronaut. They have also imagined being a child in 1969 and watching the landing on a neighbour's television with all of the other neighbours who did not own one themselves. Children wrote a diary about what they saw on the broadcast.

<u>World War 2</u> – Year 5 and 6 pupils have recorded their own radio broadcast this week about the Coventry Blitz. They reported on the destruction caused by the bombs and recounted eyewitness statements describing what happened.

<u>Challenge Mary!</u> – The Year 2 children had great fun challenging Mary this week. They all ran extreme well and we were very surprised how many were able to complete the full mile, and still wanted to do extra laps! Mr Plumbe embraced the challenge as well, and was able to pass the finish line before Mary. A huge well done to Daniel and Jack who were the first two pupils from Year 2 to finish the four laps.



### Reminders -
