Forest School - Year 1 and 2 children have been making Bug Hotels and birdfeeders to encourage natural wildlife in the garden, as part of their topic on growing plants. The children have been finding out in science lessons about the importance of insects and birds in helping new plants to grow - and having lots of fun in the meantime!

Fire Safety Demonstrations - Children in year 1 and 5 received a fire safety demonstration on Tuesday by Warwickshire Fire and Rescue Service. They gave a very informative talk about fire safety in the home and how to keep ourselves safe.

Indian Dancing – Year 3 and 4 children (and their parents!) gave a colourful and energetic performance of Indian Dancing on Thursday. The dance moves were called “Dhandia Raas” which is a stick dance that comes from the state of Gujarat in India.

The children explored tropical plants in the Temperate House, designed brochures to attract new visitors and carried out tree surveys in the gardens.
