<u>Y2 Multiskills Festival</u> – Some of our year 2 children took part in a Multiskills festival on Thursday last week, well done to all of the children who took part and thank you to parents for transport and support.

Ogden Trust Primary Scientist of the Year Award — The University of Birmingham School of Physics & Astronomy, hosted an awards evening on Thursday to celebrate the talent of exceptional students studying Physics in the Birmingham, Solihull & surrounding schools. Congratulations to our Year 6 pupil, Joe Richardson, who was given the award for Primary Scientist of the Year!

<u>Symphony Hall Visit</u> - Year 5 pupils visited the Symphony Hall in Birmingham along with pupils from St. Nicholas' Primary to experience the 'Science of Sound'. They will be taking part in a follow up session with in early July to further embed their learning experience.

<u>Safety at the School Gate</u> – Parents should use the car park behind the fire station when coming to school by car and not park across the drives of our neighbours.
