Dear Parents, Pupils & Governors,

Safety at the School Gate – Following a recent ‘near miss’ I have discussed my continuing concerns about the impact of irresponsible parking on the school grounds with the Governing Body and the local Police. I would like to reiterate that cars **should not** park opposite and around the drop off zone as it impedes access and endangers children – the yellow lines and cones indicate where **not** to park. All pedestrians should use the pedestrian access and **not** the vehicle gates.
