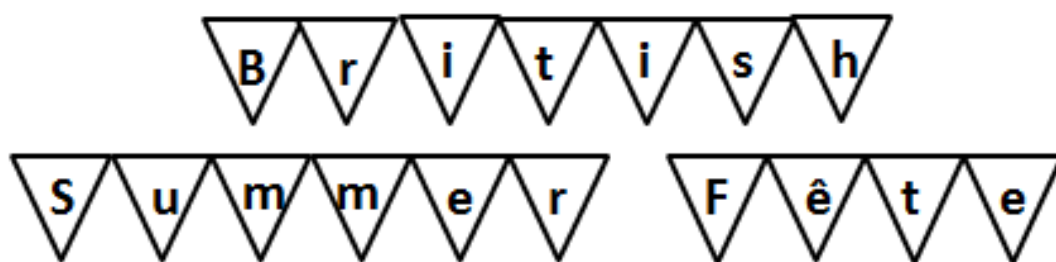
- Teacher Training Day - Friday 22nd May – School closed to children.
