Jo had worked with our pupils for 10 years teaching the girls with selfless enthusiasm. He was very special – a cheerful friendly face who will be deeply missed. Our thoughts go out to his family.

#### Athletics -

- Congratulations to all of our pupils who took part in the annual Arden area athletics competition at Stratford school last week. We have several children (who will be notified shortly) that have qualified for the next round which will be held on Monday July 6<sup>th</sup> in school time.
- Some of our KS1 children took part in a multi-skills competition on Wednesday at Alcester Academy. Activities included running, throwing and jumping. 
