Coventry Cathedral Trip – Following the successful visit last week by the Year 3 and 4 children, pupils in Year 5 and 6 went to Coventry Cathedral for their Second World War topic. They had a lesson in a 1940s classroom and discussed the importance of peace and reconciliation in families and the wider community. Together they created a recipe for peace. We have enjoyed seeing pupils, staff and volunteers dressed in period costume, especially Captain Cooney and his Land Girls!
