Dear Parents, Pupils & Governors,

Year 1 Topic Maths 'Jack and the Beanstalk' - A visit from a not-so-friendly giant prompted some exciting work from year 1 pupils in Maths, English and Geography. After planting some magic beans, an enormous beanstalk grew in the classroom – then the next morning we discovered some giant footprints in the playground! Children wrote warning posters for the village in case the giant was still lurking, and then measured the giant footprints and compared them to their own. One of the giant footprints was 240cm long, so we think the giant must be 6 times taller (15 metres 60 centimetres)! Children also created a map showing the physical and human features of the Land of the Giants using symmetrical patterns.

Pop Up Planetarium – Children and their parents joined us last week for our Family Learning night in a Warwick University's Pop Up Planetarium. We explored our Solar System and learned about life on earth in a 3D animated show entitled 'We are Aliens'.
