<u>Staff News</u> - This week we have said goodbye to Miss Crothall who is leaving us to continue her own learning journey. All of reception children were invited to dress up as fairies and things that fly as part of our Traditional Tales Topic and to say farewell.

<u>Maths Presentation</u> – On Tuesday staff led a presentation to parents of children in KS1 explaining how we teach Maths in school and how parents can help their child. The session included how we teach the four main operations (+,-,x) and \div and place value.
