<u>Reception</u> – Children in the Reception classrooms have been sharing their favourite nursery rhymes this week and learning about rhyming words. The pupils have been illustrating the stories with some amazing artwork for the display outside the classroom.

<u>Science</u> – Pupils in Year 5 and 6 have been learning about the different parts of the eye in their science work. They have labelled diagrams with the different parts and have learnt more about how the eye works with the brain in order for us to be able to see.

Covid Arrangements

Do not park on or opposite the yellow zigzags - free parking is available in the Wards Lane carpark only a short walk away.

Children in Mrs Satchwell's class who are not going to PGL will have an additional PE session on Friday. Children should come to school in their PE kit on their PE day.
