Over the week, the children have been learning about Mental Health and ways to look after themselves, such as regular exercise, talking about their emotions and breathing techniques. Some of our KS2 pupils also had workshops delivered by our Educational Mental Health Practitioners and these will continue on Monday for the classes yet to be visited.

If you are driving your child to school, please park and walk your child in school using the school crossing rather than crossing the road between cars.
