<u>KS1 Health Topic</u> - To launch their new topic about Health, children in Year 1 and 2 had a visit from St John's Ambulance. The children learnt about First Aid with Mr Williams who also explained to pupils about how to phone the emergency services. The children were then invited to have a look around inside the ambulance. The Reception children also managed to sneak a look inside the ambulance while KS1 were not looking!

#### Science -

- Children in Years 3 & 4 have been producing mind maps about their new topic, States of Matter. The children have researched different states of matter and written about examples of solids, liquids and gases outlining their properties.
- Year 5 & 6 pupils have been learning about the importance of taking medicinal drugs safely and understanding why exercise is important for our health. They have also been finding out about the main parts of the human circulatory system.

<u>Tudor Topic</u> – Children in Year 4 have become fashion designers this week, designing, making and sewing their own Tudor purse. They also wrote a persuasive letter to Pope Clement requesting that Henry have a divorce from Catherine of Aragon. They tea-stained their paper to make it look aged and signed Henry's name with a quill and ink.

#### **Covid Arrangements**

- This week we have had a significant increase of covid infections in school. Please help us to limit further

  visitors that come into the school building <u>wear a face covering</u>.
