<u>Mini Beasts Hunt</u> – Children in the Reception classes have enjoyed hunting for mini beasts under the logs and plants in forest school this week. After finding a variety of different creatures including worms, millipedes, centipedes, beetles and woodlice, they created their own mini beasts to go in their garden display.

<u>Surprise Visit</u> - The Reception children had unexpected visit from a pair of ducks on Friday morning just as they were going out for their PE lesson. After spending a few minutes looking at how the male and female duck differed, the children went off to PE singing duck songs!

<u>Mental Health Workshops</u> – Children in KS2 have taken part in workshops with the Education Mental Health Practitioners this week. Year 5 and 6 have been talking about problem solving and resilience and Year 3 and 4 focussed on the importance of good sleep routine.

<u>Class Photos</u> – Pupils will be having their class photos taken by Tempest Photography on Mon 28th March. If your child has PE or Forest School on this day, please send them into school in their normal uniform with their PE kit or Forest School things in a separate bag.

The role is part time for 100 hours spread throughout the school year and will be a mix of working from home and attending Governing Body meetings in person. Covid Arrangements

- Over the last <u>three</u> weeks we have had <u>86 children and 11 members of staff</u> test positive with Covid.
 Please help us to limit further spread by wearing a face covering while on the school site and maintain social distancing wherever possible. Our staff will continue to wear masks in corridors and communal areas and we ask that <u>ALL</u> visitors that come into the school building <u>wear a face covering</u>.
- If your child is unwell, they should remain at home until they are well enough to return. If your child becomes ill whilst at school, you will be asked to collect them. If they have symptoms of Covid-19 they should remain at home and take a test. If your child has a positive test, they can return to school following 2 consecutive negative tests from day 5.
