<u>Year 6 SATs</u> – Well done to all our Year 6 children who have taken their SATs this week. They have all worked really hard to do their best. As a reward for all their effort the children enjoyed a non-curriculum day on Friday including making dens in Forest School and taking part in sports activities.

<u>Seaside Topic</u> – Pupils in Year 1 and 2 carried out a survey amongst the children about different beaches they have visited, they then looked at the map to locate the resort. This may be a good opportunity for parents to continue this at home by getting out photos of the family on the beach and talking about what they did and saw.

<u>Maths</u> - Children in Years 3 and 4 have been looking at money during their maths lessons, converting between pounds and pence and estimating how much money they think items will cost based on their knowledge of rounding.

#### **Reminders:**
