<u>Girls Football Tournament</u> – Our school sent two teams to the Girls Football tournament at Alcester Town Football Club on Thursday. <u>Computing</u> – Pupils in Years 3 and 4 have been learning how to use the computer program LOGO. This programming software enables children to draw 2D shapes that they then repeated to draw a square flower.

<u>Field Sketching</u> - This week, children in Mrs Satchwell's class have learnt how to do a field sketch. They practised first by using a photograph of a landscape and then went on to the school field to finesse their technique, labelling the features they could see and determining whether they were human or physical features
