### NEWSLETTER 1 – 9<sup>th</sup> September 2022

**Welcome** to the new school year – everyone arrived looking smart in their uniforms and it is lovely to have all the pupils back in school along with our new Reception children.

**The Queen** – It was with great sadness that we held our Collective Worship today focusing on the life of Her Majesty the Queen. We thought about how during her long and remarkable life, she was a role model for us all, performing her duties with dedication and commitment, becoming a focus for national identity and pride. The latest guidance from the government indicates that school will remain open during the period of official mourning and we will inform parents of any change.

<u>Term Time Holiday Information from Attendance Compliance Enforcement Service</u> – Please read the page below outlining the Warwickshire County Council policy on term time leave of absence. This information is also shown on our school website.

<u>Contact Details & Consent (GDPR)</u> – This week your child has brought home an envelope containing their Data collection sheet. Please check the details carefully and amend as required. It is important that we have up to date contact information and safeguarding regulations require us to have at least <u>2</u> emergency contacts. Please remember to sign the form on the back page. All signed forms should be returned by <u>Monday 12<sup>th</sup> Sep.</u> Our Privacy Notice detailing how we use information about children is on our school website.

**<u>COVID-19</u>** - If your child has a positive test for Covid-19, please keep them at home for 3 days after the positive test. They can return to school so long as they are feeling better and have no symptoms.

<u>Celebration Collective Worship</u> - We will be starting Celebration Collective Worship for children in Years 1 to 6 again on Fri 16<sup>th</sup> Sept at 2.45pm. If your child has earned an award outside of school for their attainment in a specific activity (e.g. swimming, music, gymnastics) they are able to bring it in and have it presented in front of the other children. We do not accept certificates for attendance at theme parks, holiday or sports clubs. Please bring in certificates/trophies before the end of Thursday.

**School Meals** – The price of a school meal is now £2.40 for children in KS2 and are free for children in Reception & KS1. Families of children entitled to income dependent free school meals should still register so that we can claim *Pupil Premium of up to £1385* to help support your child in school. Please go to www.warwickshire.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals to apply or contact us in confidence for further information. *Delibags* are available for children in Reception and KS1. These must be ordered at morning registration and orders cannot be changed at lunchtime. School meals are ordered at registration each morning so please ensure your child is familiar with the menu choice before coming into school. Menus can be found on the school website.

<u>Nut Allergies</u> - Several children and staff in school have severe nut allergies. Please help us ensure their safety by not including any nut products in packed lunches.

**<u>Reception</u>** – Children in Reception should come into school by the normal time of 8.55am. The gates will be open at 8.45am and parents should keep right of the dividing barrier allowing the KS1 children access to the playground.

**<u>Parking</u>** – There is no parking parent on the school site during drop off and pick up times. Pleas use the car park in Wards Lane, behind the Fire Station.

<u>Milk</u> – If you would like your child to receive milk during the school day, please apply online at <u>www.coolmilk.com</u>. Children who are **under 5** receive free milk, but parents still need to apply online. Children who qualify for welfare free school meals are also entitled to free milk – please ask at the office.

<u>Clubs</u> – Emails have been sent this week with details of after school clubs starting next week and a link to register online:

**Bellboating** – The Year 5 and 6 children will be going bellboating next week and should come to school wearing plenty of layers – t-shirt/sweatshirt/fleece/joggers/tracksuit (not jeans) with a rain jacket (and waterproof trousers if they have some). Children should also bring spare clothes in a carrier bag.

Miss Waters' class – Monday 12<sup>th</sup> Sept, Mrs Mills' Class Weds 14<sup>th</sup> Sept & Miss Powell's class Thurs 15<sup>th</sup>.

<u>Year 4 Swimming</u> – Sessions begin on Weds 14<sup>th</sup> Sept - pupils in Year 4 should come to school in their PE kit with their swimming kit in a named bag.

<u>Year 6 PGL</u> – The PGL parent meeting will be held in school on Weds 14<sup>th</sup> Sept at 6.30pm. Parents are invited to attend. Children will have a meeting in school time so should not come in the evening.

**Forest School** – On Forest School days, children should come to school wearing their Forest School clothes and bring their wellies and waterproofs in a bag. Please note this is a change from the previous instruction.

**Book Bags** – Children in KS1 should use book bags for transporting books to and from school - please do not use a rucksack. Book bags can be purchased from the school office.

**<u>Reading Books</u>** – Please check at home for school reading books that you may still have from last year. Home reading books will begin to be issued over the next few weeks in line with our homework policy.

<u>Clothing</u> - All children should have a coat for playtimes and come into school in their full PE kit on their PE days (not Reception). Please ensure everything is named – we have already had some mislaid items!

<u>School website</u> – Please use our website <u>www.bidfordonavon.warwickshire.sch.uk</u> to find lots of useful information about school including term dates, diary dates, dinner menus, newsletters, activities and policies.

<u>Volunteers</u> – We are always grateful for volunteers to come and help support us with activities e.g. reading, sewing, school trips. If you would be able to help us please call into the school office. A Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check would be required.

<u>School Admissions</u> – If you have a child moving to Secondary school from September 2023 applications need to be made by 31<sup>st</sup> Oct 2022, you may find the following information from School Admissions helpful:

#### WCC Attendance Compliance Enforcement Service

#### Leave of Absence

The Government issued new regulations in September 2013 regarding Leave of Absence; The Education (Pupil Regulations) (England) Regulations 2006 as amended by Education (Pupil Regulations) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2013

- Head teachers shall not grant any Leave of Absence during term time unless they consider there are exceptional circumstances relating to the application.
- Parents do not have any entitlement to take their children on holiday during term time. Any application for leave must establish that there are **exceptional circumstances** and the Head Teacher must be satisfied that the circumstances warrant the granting of leave.
- Head Teachers will determine how many school days a child may be absent from school if the leave is granted.
- The school can only consider applications for Leave of Absence which are made by the resident parent. i.e the parent with whom the child normally resides.
- Applications for Leave of Absence must be made in advance and failure to do so will result in the absence being recorded as "unauthorised". This may result in legal action against the parent, by way of a Fixed Penalty Notice.
- Applications for Leave of Absence which are made in advance and refused will result in the absence being recorded as "unauthorised". This may result in legal action against the parent, by way of a Fixed Penalty Notice, if the child is absent from school during that period.
- All matters of unauthorised absence relating to a Leave of Absence will be referred to the Warwickshire Attendance Service of Warwickshire County Council.
- The Warwickshire Attendance Service have the authority to consider issuing Fixed Penalty Notices for Leave of Absence in line with the Warwickshire County Council's Non-School Attendance and Penalty Notices Code of Conduct. - If a Fixed Penalty Notice is issued and is not paid within the timeframe set out in that Notice, the matter will be referred to Warwickshire County Council's Legal Services to consider instigating criminal prosecution proceedings under S444 of Education Act 1996.

#### Each application for a Leave of Absence will be considered on a case by case basis and on its own merits.
