<u>School Values</u> – Each term we promote a theme focusing on the values and character attributes that support our children in their learning and their life both within school and the wider community. This term our focus is on compassion and courage and we will be exploring these themes within the curriculum and in collective worship.

<u>Romans Topic</u> – Children in Years 3 and 4 class have started their Romans topic. They have been finding out about Romulus and Remus, the twin brothers whose story tells of the events that led to the founding of the city of Rome and the Roman Kingdom.

<u>Literacy</u> – Inspired by our book of the week, pupils in Mr Plumbe's class have written their own story about what might happen if a wild animal came to their house for tea. Children came up with brilliant ideas of what mischief a monkey could make if they came to tea!

PE Sessions – Due to our PGL trip next week, there will be a few changes to PE sessions and children should wear their PE kit to school on their PE day:
