<u>Governing Body</u> – At our Governors' meeting this week, we welcomed Jason Norledge as a new Parent Governor and Roger Green as a new Foundation Governor. It was the first meeting of the new school year and Rob Williams was elected as Chair.

<u>Literacy</u> – Following on from reading 'Who Let the Gods Out?' by Maz Evans, children in Mrs Mills' class have been exploring the Zodiac Signs and the character traits associated with them. They have enjoyed finding out what their zodiac sign is and what kind of person they are! They are now using this information to help create their own characters for their story writing.

<u>Science Day</u> – Some of the Year 1 children went to an Ogden Trust Science Day at Mount Carmel Primary School with Mrs Mansbridge this week. The pupils learnt about forces and how they work. They were challenged to build the tallest and strongest spaghetti tower (Bidford were proud runners up), and make rocket mice to see who could shoot their mouse up the highest by using different sized empty bottles and differing amounts of force. There were mice whizzing all around the classroom and great fun was had by all the children (and adults!) who took part.

- From Mon 17th Oct, children in Reception should be dropped off at the small green gate by the Reception playground. Reception children will then walk into the classrooms independently. Any messages for class teachers should be sent in with your child or you can write a 'yellow note' in the office foyer.

- If you are the parent of a child in Year 6, you will need to apply for their Year 7 place in a secondary school by the deadline of Monday 31 October. The admissions team are hosting a <u>Secondary School Applications</u> <u>Webinar</u> on Tues 18th Oct at 7pm giving advice and guidance on how to choose your preferred schools and submit an application.
- If your child sat the 11+ test in Warwickshire this year and you are considering applying for a grammar school place, there is an 11+ Results Webinar on Thurs 20th Oct at 7pm. This aims to help you interpret your child's test results and how to use them to make informed choices on which secondary schools to include on your application.
