<u>Superheroes</u> - As part of their topic about Superheroes, the Reception children have been reading the story of Supertato! They have been making posters with messages and designing traps to catch the evil pea! The children are looking forward to their superhero dressing up day on **Weds 23rd Nov.** If you have any plain pillow cases that you no longer need, please send them into school for us to use. We will be working with the children to decorate the pillow cases using fabric pens, to use as capes for superhero role play costumes.

<u>Romans</u> - Children in Miss Sheehan's class have been designing their own mosaic patterns. Pupils were given a choice of commonly used Roman symbols for the middle of their mosaics, which included a sword, shield, gladiator or wolf.

<u>Nativity</u> – It is beginning to feel festive in school this week as children in Years 1 & 2 learn new songs during their Nativity rehearsals. Tickets for the performances have now been sent home. If you have tickets that you do not need, please drop them in to the office so that we can give them to other families.

<u>Tree Planting</u> – We have recently had a new tree planted in the grounds at the front of the school. 17 years ago, Aaron planted an apple seed when he was in Year 3. He has nurtured it carefully over the years and now kindly donated it for us to enjoy.

<u>FIFA World Cup</u> — With the FIFA World Cup commencing shortly, our classes have organized their own sweepstakes with the 32 teams taking part. The child with the winning team in each class will receive a football.

<u>Year 5 & 6 Trip</u> – Children in Years 5 & 6 are going to The British Museum on Mon 21st Nov. Children <u>must</u> <u>be at school for 7.45am</u>, so the coach can leave by 8am. Children will return to school at approximately 7pm. Please remember to bring a coat, lunch and a snack. School uniform should be worn (girls may wear black leggings if they would rather not wear a dress/skirt and don't have school trousers).

<u>Wellbeing Enrichment Days</u> - During w/c 21st Nov, all classes will be having a Wellbeing Enrichment Day. Pupils will be able to experience two new sports and participate in some resilience work with Lucas Jet Circus team. Your child will need to come to school wearing their PE kit on the day they have their enrichment activities with extra layers as they will be outside.

After school, Lucas Jet Circus will be selling some of the equipment your child will have used during the session, these could make great Christmas presents and it would be wonderful for your child to show you their new skills at home.
