

<u>Reception</u> – have been reading the story of The Three Little Pigs. They have drawn pictures of a new home for the pigs. The children have been using story language to retell this tale. They also all enjoyed their first PE session in the school hall.

KS1 (Y1,Y1/2 & Y2) — have been finishing our English unit on Toys in Space by writing a character description of Cuddles. We made lost and found posters and the children enjoyed drawing pictures. In History, the children have enjoyed learning about technology from the past including old phones and even having the chance to hold an old cassette player and an old digital camera. They are doing a great job at developing their knowledge of items and technology from the past.



<u>LKS2 (Y3, Y3/4 & Y4)</u> —have been working hard this week learning about how the Romans built their empire. They looked at maps of how their rule changed and they were amazed by just how much of Europe was taken over. It has also been amazing to see them working so hard in their English work. They have planned their narratives based on the Greedy Zebra and Year 4 are already starting to write their stories. If your child is in Year 4, ask them what they can say in French - we have been learning about greetings!

<u>UKS2 (Y5, Y5/6 & Y6</u>)- have been learning about inherited characteristics, how certain characteristics are inherited from your parents and how others are developed through the environment in which we live. They also had great fun Bellboating this week. They rowed down steam first and went through the lock. They saw some great wildlife including: a kingfisher and a heron. Miss Drissell thought she saw a crocodile but she didn't have her glasses on so it might just have been a ripple in the water - who knows! Coming back up stream was much harder work and the children had to work as a team to get back to the meadow and earn their lunch. After lunch, we boated up to the weir and 'tried' and failed to get over it. Thank you to all of our volunteers who helped us with this event.
