Reception – have had an exciting week - they had a visit from two parent paramedics on Monday. They learnt

lots of new things about the different equipment they carry on an ambulance. The children got to go in the ambulance and have a look around as well as sitting in the driver's seat and turning the lights and siren on. We want to say a huge thank you for coming in and visit us. On Tuesday the children had an enrichment day. They took part in target practise, cup stacking and yoga. On top of all of this, Evil Pea has made an appearance in the Reception classes, he has been up to no good and has taken a few items from the class. Let us know if you see him out and about!!



KS1 (Y1, Y1/2 & Y2) – Nativity prep has begun and we greatly appreciate the parents support in helping the children learn their lines. In class, they have moved away from focusing on numbers this week and learning more about geometry. In their English lessons, they have finished their suitcase story with a letter of apology which the children thoroughly enjoyed writing!

LKS2 (Y3, Y3/4 & Y4) – In English this week, the children have been exploring the features of a successful set of instructions and applying this to writing their own, based on how to build a Roman road. We have discussed the reasons why the Roman Empire fell all those years ago in preparation for the following invaders. In Fox Class, they have started to practise their reading music skills and playing the glockenspiels in time to some backing music - Mr Morris was extremely impressed as he walked past!

<u>UKS2 (Y5, Y5/6 & Y6</u>) – have been learning about the Parthenon (temple of Athena) in Topic and have created their own fact pages based on the information they have found out. In Science, they have been learning about the formation of fossils and how their existence has helped scientists such as: Charles Darwin, develop their theories of Evolution.


